Old Business: There was no old business

New Business:

- Approval of Pastor Sloka as a full administrator for Breeze. Jenny made the motion seconded by Dan to have Pastor Sloka become one of the administrators for the Breeze program. Motion Carried.
- James R.& Sylvia Stevens Foundation-Keith reported that the foundation was created through the North Dakota Community Foundation and would be run through them. It was created for use by St. Paul and the Garrison Community. Local people working with the foundation include Keith Thelen from our church, Sundi Lagge from Tru-Community Bank and Shannon Jeffers from the City Council. Grants will be available each year. Applications for grants are due on September 15 th . Pastor Janis has submitted an application for the projector project.
- Concrete Patching- Shannon Jeffers would like to try different ways to repair areas in front of the church. The council agreed that this was a great idea and was appreciative of his help in finding solutions.


